

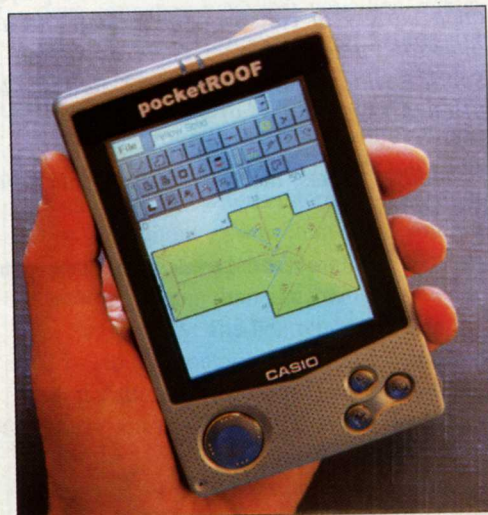
The Computer Shrinks Again

(Or has the electronic calculator grown?)

It finally happened: Someone invented a device small enough to carry on the rooftop in a shirt pocket, but powerful enough to store drawings and dimensions of a roof area in exhaustive detail. AppliCad Australia introduced the PocketROOF system at the recent NRCA Convention in Atlanta, and roofing contractors from all over showed a great deal of interest in this new and innovative product.

PocketROOF is an estimating program for the Windows CE based palm-sized computer. In addition to estimating software, the basic unit will also provide busy roofing contractors a way to keep important information such as contact lists and appointment schedules.

Data may be entered into the hand-held computer by text, written note or voice. All data entered into the unit may be uploaded into the contractor's personal computer following a day in the field. Data may also be downloaded from the PC to the hand-held computer. Data gathered at the job site may be further manipulated on the PC and used to document or prepare written reports, proposals, or other correspondence using AppliCad's Sorcerer software program. The estimating software features easy roof drawing commands that allow the estimator to set roof slope, or multiple
